Napa Junior Girls Halloween Bash Schedule & Rules Updated 10/10/22

Rules

Round Robin will determine seeding for Saturday's tournament.

Games will be no new inning after **one hour and ten minutes** including the Championship and Consolation Game. The 5 run rule will be in effect.

No new inning will begin after one hour and ten minutes. All innings started will be completed, unless the home team is batting and they are ahead when the game time limit expires. A new inning begins on the clock the moment the third out is made against the home team.

Home team will be decided by a coin toss for the Round Robin . For Saturday's Tournament Home team will be the highest seed determined from the Round Robin.

Home team will keep the official book. The umpire's watch is the official game time. The home book will log in the umpire's start time.

No infield practice allowed on any field throughout the tournament. Foul areas along the 1st and 3rd baselines may be used to warm-up.

ALL Pitchers are limited to 2 innings per game. If a game goes into a 5th inning or an international tie breaker then it becomes unlimited.

Halloween Bash Costumes must be appropriate for softball play. (ie, no capes, masks,) and Numbers must be visible. The Executive Board will make judgement calls.

Coaches are asked to remove trash and vacate dugouts quickly after each game. Halloween Bash decorations will need to be cleared from the field side of the cyclone fence prior to games starting.

It's the Coach's responsibility to respect the decorations of the dugouts.

No game may end in a tie. International tie breaker rules will be in effect.

International Tiebreaker Rule: When a regulation game ends in a tie, the International Tiebreaker rule is used. At the beginning of each team's at-bat the last batter from the previous inning is placed on 2nd base. It is not sudden death. Each team has an opportunity to bat each inning. The game ends when one team is ahead at the end of the inning.

If a game is tied and is called due to daylight the tie will be settled by a coin toss.

If a team is ahead by 10 runs or more after 5 innings, the game will be called. The game will be called when the hour and ten time limit expires if one team is more than 5 runs ahead, even if the inning is not completed.

Protests should be taken to the Tournament Director. As per NJGSL rule #6.2.4, immediate rulings of all protests will be made by the designated umpire in chief and executive board member.
